THE THEFT OF THE REUSABLE PLASTIC TRAYS OCCURS IN A FEW DIFFERENT SETTINGS:

- **Criminal organizations** Organizations that are engaged in illegal regrinding operations
- **Corporate theft** Some companies try to evade capital expenditure costs by stealing other companies' reusable plastic trays
- **Improper retail use or disposal** The retailer uses the reusable plastic trays for a different purpose than is intended

Baking companies are serving as model environmental stewards by investing in reusable plastic trays for distribution. Due to the widespread theft of reusable plastic trays from the baking industry's supply chain, we need legislative action to increase the penalties for this crime.
